

Who can receive services through Family Caregiver Support Program?

Services are available to unpaid caregivers who are:

~ Providing in-home or community based care to older adult, age 60 or older; or,

~ Providing in-home or community based care to a person of any age with Alzheimer's disease or related disorder with neurological or organic brain dysfunction; or

~ Grandparents or other relative parent (aunt, uncle, cousin, sibling) who are age 55 or older and are providing care to a child 18 years or younger or to an adult with disabilities. You must be related to the child or adult with disabilities by blood, marriage, or adoption. The child or adult with disabilities must live with you and you are the primary caregiver because the biological or adoptive parents are unable or unwilling to serve as the primary caregiver.

There is no cost to you to enroll in the Family Caregiver Support Program. There are also no income or resource guidelines for this program.
